SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AQUATIC RESOURCES DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO BEGIN A RULEMAKING PROCESS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 187A-5, HAWAII REVISED STATUTES, TO AMEND THE ADMINISTRATIVE RULES, AS NECESSARY, TO RESOLVE THE USER CONFLICTS BETWEEN COMMERCIAL AKULE FISHERMEN AND RECREATIONAL POLE FISHING IN VARIOUS HARBORS ON KAUAI.

WHEREAS, there has been and continues to be user conflict
 between commercial akule fishermen and recreational pole fishing
 in various harbors on Kauai, including Port Allen and
 Nawiliwili; and

6 WHEREAS, there have been allegations that the commercial
7 akule fishermen have been depleting fish stocks to the detriment
8 of recreational pole fishing in these areas; and

10 WHEREAS, in other harbors statewide comparable situations 11 have been addressed through legislation and administrative 12 rules; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fourth 14 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2008, the 15 House of Representatives concurring, that the Aquatic Resources 16 Division of the Department of Land and Natural Resources 17 18 (Department) is requested to begin a rulemaking process, pursuant to section 187A-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to review 19 the current status of the user conflict between commercial akule 20 fishermen and recreational pole fishing in various harbors on 21 Kauai, to hold public meetings, and to recommend rule changes 22 23 that would better balance the use conflicts between the two parties; and 24

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26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the rulemaking process is 27 requested to begin as soon as possible and that the Department 28 is requested to report to the Legislature no later than twenty

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days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2009, on 1 the status of the adoption of any relevant rules; and 2 3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 4 5 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources. 6 7 8 log L. 9 OFFERED BY:
