SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT A FINANCIAL AND MANAGEMENT AUDIT OF THE NATURAL ENERGY LABORATORY OF HAWAII AUTHORITY'S DEEP SEAWATER PUMPING SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the Natural Energy Laboratory of Hawaii Authority 1 (NELHA) was created with the intent to facilitate research and 2 development of natural energy resources and ocean-related 3 research; and 4 5 WHEREAS, NELHA is in the unique position, not just in the 6 State of Hawaii, but in the world, to develop and produce three 7 very basic needs: food, energy, and healthcare; and 8 9 WHEREAS, the State has invested nearly \$70,000,000 into 10 NELHA infrastructure over a period of more than 30 years; and 11 12 13 WHEREAS, NELHA pumps deep, cold, and pure seawater from waters 2000-feet deep off the coast of the island of Hawaii for 14 use by its commercial tenants, and for energy production and air 15 conditioning; and 16 17 WHEREAS, currently, more than 90 percent of the 18 approximately 14,500 gallons of this seawater is used by its 19 aquaculture tenants each minute; and 20 21 WHEREAS, the rate structure for pumped seawater should be 22 reasonably set; now, therefore, 23 24 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fourth 25 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2008, the 26 House of Representatives concurring, that the Auditor is 27 requested to conduct a financial and management audit of the 28 deep seawater pumping system operated by NELHA, with the goal of 29 evaluating the rate structure for pumped seawater and, if 30 necessary, determining a reasonable rate structure; and 31



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2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to submit a report of any findings and recommendations to the 3 Legislature no later than 20 days prior to the convening of the 4 Regular Session of 2009; and 5

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that NELHA is requested to freeze the rate that it charges for pumped seawater at the level in 8 effect on the enrollment date of this concurrent resolution, 9 until the Auditor completes the audit, at which time it is 10 requested to implement the rate structure recommended by the 11 Auditor; and 12

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 14 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, President 15 of the Senate, Speaker of the House of Representatives, 16 Department of Agriculture, Natural Energy Laboratory of Hawaii 17 Authority, and the Hawaii Aquaculture Association. 18
