A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE SUPERVISION OF ADULT OFFENDERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 353B, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: 4 **"§353B- Interstate transfer fee.** The judiciary may 5 assess a fee not to exceed \$200 for each application made by a 6 parolee or probationer for a transfer out of the State; provided 7 that the fees collected shall be deposited into the State's 8 general fund." 9 SECTION 2. Section 353B-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 10 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 11 "(a) There is established the state council for interstate 12 adult offender supervision, which shall be placed 13 administratively in the judiciary. The council shall be 14 composed of [five] nine members to be appointed as follows: 15 (1) One member of the house of representatives appointed

by the speaker of the house of representatives;

- 2 consecutively to more than two terms.
- 3 There shall be one full-time coordinator position for the
- 4 supervision of adult offenders. The coordinator shall be
- 5 appointed by the judiciary."
- 6 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
