If you joined us for the stakeholder meeting on July 18, 2007, please note that this February 1 meeting will take place at ICF International, which is <u>next door</u> to the Greater Washington Board of Trade.

Nearest Metro Stations: (Both stations are less than a 5 minute walk from 1725 I Street.)

<u>Farragut North Metro Station</u>, located on the **Red Line**. Exit in the direction of K Street. When you come out of the Metro, walk across K Street. (You will be walking towards a small park.) You will be standing at the corner of 17th Street and K Street. Walk down 17th Street for one block, with the park on your left hand side, to the corner of 17th Street and I (Eye) Street. Walk across 17th Street to the opposite corner and 1727 I (Eye) Street is a few buildings down the street, on your right hand side.

<u>Farragut West Metro Station</u>, located on the **Blue & Orange** Lines. Exit in the direction of 17th Street. Make a left as you come off the escalators and out of the Metro. You will be at the corner of 17th Street and I (Eye) Street. Walk across I (Eye) Street, and then immediately across 17th Street, so you are now diagonally across the street from the Metro station. 1727 I (Eye) Street is a few buildings down the street, on your right hand side.
