## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this bill is to change the name
- 2 of the "board of medical examiners", established pursuant to
- 3 section 453-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the "Hawaii medical
- 4 board".
- 5 SECTION 2. Section 453-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 6 amended by amending its title and subsection (a) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 "\$453-5 [Board of medical examiners;] Hawaii medical
- 9 board; appointment, removal, qualifications. (a) For the
- 10 purpose of carrying out this chapter, the governor shall appoint
- 11 a [board of medical examiners,] Hawaii medical board whose duty
- 12 it shall be to examine all applicants for license to practice
- 13 medicine or surgery. As used in this chapter, "board" means the
- 14 [board of medical examiners.] Hawaii medical board.
- The board shall consist of eleven persons, seven of whom
- 16 shall be physicians or surgeons licensed under the laws of the
- 17 State, two of whom shall be osteopathic physicians licensed
- 18 under the laws of the State, and two of whom shall be lay

- 1 members appointed from the public at large. Of the nine members
- 2 who are physicians, surgeons, or osteopathic physicians, at
- 3 least five shall be appointed from the city and county of
- 4 Honolulu and at least one shall be appointed from each of the
- 5 other counties. Medical societies in the various counties may
- 6 conduct elections periodically but no less frequently than every
- 7 two years to determine nominees for the board to be submitted to
- 8 the governor. In making appointments, the governor may consider
- 9 recommendations submitted by the medical societies and the
- 10 public at large. Each member shall serve until a successor is
- 11 appointed and qualified."
- 12 SECTION 3. The revisor of statutes shall replace the term
- 13 "board of medical examiners" or like term whenever it may appear
- 14 in the Hawaii Revised Statutes, with the term "Hawaii medical
- 15 board".
- 16 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 18 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
