A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE LAND USE COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 205-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended to read as follows:

3 "§205-17 Land use commission decision-making criteria. In
4 its review of any petition for reclassification of district
5 boundaries pursuant to this chapter, the commission shall
6 specifically consider the following:

7	(1)	The extent to which the proposed reclassification
8		conforms to the applicable goals, objectives, and
9		policies of the Hawaii state plan and relates to the
10		applicable priority guidelines of the Hawaii state
11		plan and the adopted functional plans;
12	(2)	The extent to which the proposed reclassification
13		conforms to the applicable district standards;
14	(3)	The impact of the proposed reclassification on the
15		following areas of state concern:
16		(A) Preservation or maintenance of important natural

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systems or habitats;



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1		(B)	Maintenance of valued cultural, historical, or	
2			natural resources;	
3		(C)	Maintenance of other natural resources relevant	
4			to Hawaii's economy, including agricultural	
5			resources;	
6		(D)	Commitment of state funds and resources;	
7		(E)	Provision for employment opportunities and	
8			economic development; and	
9		(F)	Provision for housing opportunities for all	
10			income groups, particularly the low,	
11			low-moderate, and gap groups;	
12	(4)	The s	tandards and criteria for the reclassification or	
13		rezon	ing of important agricultural lands in section	
14		205-5	0; [and]	
15	<u>(5)</u>	The county general plan and all community,		
16		devel	opment, or community development plans adopted	
17		pursu	ant to the county general plan, as they relate to	
18		<u>the l</u>	and that is the subject of the reclassification

20	[(5)]	(6)	The representations and commitments made by the	
21		petit	ioner in securing a boundary change."
