A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE MUSEUM OF HAWAIIAN MUSIC AND DANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the museum of
2 Hawaiian music and dance committee, constituted pursuant to Act
3 230, Session Laws of Hawaii 2007, is presently commencing its
4 study to determine the appropriate type of institution that
5 should be established, as well as the details thereto, for a
6 museum of Hawaiian music and dance. The legislature further
7 finds that the museum of Hawaiian music and dance committee
8 needs an extension of time to file its reports in order that a
9 thorough and detailed study can be made.

10 The purpose of this Act is to extend the time for the
11 museum of Hawaiian music and dance committee to file its reports
12 as required under Act 230, Session Laws of Hawaii 2007.

13 SECTION 2. Act 230, Session Laws of Hawaii 2007, is
14 amended as follows:

15 1. By amending subsection (d) of section 2 to read:

16 "(d) The committee shall cease to exist on June 30,
17 [~~2008~~] 2009."



1 2. By amending section 3 to read:

2 "SECTION 3. (a) The committee shall submit [~~an interim~~
3 report of its findings and recommendations to the legislature no
4 later than [~~twenty days prior to the convening of the regular~~
5 ~~session of 2008.~~] September 15, 2008.

6 (b) The committee shall submit a final report to the
7 legislature [~~prior to June 30, 2008,~~] no later than twenty days
8 prior to the convening of the regular session of 2009, that
9 contains:

10 (1) A detailed account of how all funds provided for the
11 committee were expended; and

12 (2) Plans for the future direction of the museum of
13 Hawaiian music and dance."

14 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

16 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
