A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENDANGERING THE WELFARE OF A MINOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 709-903.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended b	y amending subsection (1) to read as follows:	
3	"(1)	Except as provided in subsection (2), a person	
4	commits t	he offense of endangering the welfare of a minor in the	
5	first deg	ree if, having care or custody of a minor, the person:	
6	(a)	Intentionally or knowingly allows another person to	
7		inflict serious or substantial bodily injury on the	
8		minor; or	
9	(b)	Intentionally or knowingly causes or permits the minor	
10	*	to inject, ingest [methamphetamine.], inhale, or	
11		otherwise introduce into the minor's body any	
12		controlled substance listed in sections 329-14,	
13		329-16, 329-18, and 329-20 that has not been	
14		prescribed by a physician for the minor, except as	
15		permitted under section 329-122."	
16	SECT	ION 2. Section 709-904, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
17	amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows:		

1	** (1)	Except as provided in section 709-903.5(2), a person	
2	commits t	he offense of endangering the welfare of a minor in the	
3	second de	gree if, having care or custody of a minor, the person:	
4	(a)	Recklessly allows another person to inflict serious or	
5		substantial bodily injury on the minor; or	
6	(b)	Recklessly causes or permits the minor to inject,	
7		ingest [methamphetamine.], inhale, or otherwise	
8		introduce into the minor's body any controlled	
9		substance listed in sections 329-14, 329-16, 329-18,	
10		and 329-20 that has not been prescribed by a physician	
11		for the minor, except as permitted under section	
12		329-122. This subsection shall not apply to nursing	
13		mothers who may cause the ingestion or introduction of	
14		detectable amounts of any controlled substance listed	
15		in sections 329-14, 329-16, 329-18, and 329-20 to	
16		their minor children through breastfeeding."	
17	SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that		
18	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were		
19	begun, before its effective date.		
20	SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed		
21	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.		
22	SECT	ION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
