A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO IOLANI PALACE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 6E-35, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "S6E-35 Iolani Palace. (a) The official designation of
- 4 the palace of the former monarchs of Hawaii shall be Iolani
- 5 Palace.
- 6 (b) The official designation of the Friends of Iolani
- 7 Palace shall be the State of Hawaii Museum of Monarchy History.
- 8 The qualifying standards and conditions related to the receipt
- 9 of funds under chapter 42F shall not apply to funds received by
- 10 the State of Hawaii Museum of Monarchy History; provided that if
- 11 the museum contracts with a recipient or provider, then the
- 12 qualifying standards, conditions, and other provisions of
- 13 chapter 42F shall apply to the recipient or provider and the
- 14 contract.
- 15 (c) To receive state funds, the State of Hawaii Museum of
- 16 Monarchy History shall:

1	(1)	Be licensed or accredited, in accordance with federal,
2		state, or county statutes, rules, or ordinances, to
3		conduct the activities or provide the services for
4		which funds are appropriated;
5	(2)	Comply with all applicable federal and state laws
6		prohibiting discrimination against any person on the
7		basis of race, color, national origin, religion,
8		creed, sex, age, sexual orientation, or disability;
9	(3)	Agree not to use the funds for entertainment or
10		<pre>lobbying activities;</pre>
11	(4)	Be incorporated under the laws of the State;
12	<u>(5)</u>	Have bylaws or policies that describe the manner in
13		which the activities or services for which a grant or
14		subsidy is awarded shall be conducted or provided;
15	<u>(6)</u>	Have been determined and designated to be a tax-exempt
16		organization by the Internal Revenue Service; and
17	<u>(7)</u>	Have a governing board whose members shall have no
18		material conflict of interest and serve without
19		compensation.
20	[-(c)-]	(d) The comptroller and state auditor shall have the
21	authority	to examine the use of funds appropriated to the State
22	of Hawaii	Museum of Monarchy History.

- 1 [[(d)]] (e) The State of Hawaii Museum of Monarchy History
- 2 shall provide to the legislature an annual report no later than
- 3 twenty days prior to the convening of each regular session,
- 4 which shall include an explanation of the facility maintenance
- 5 and other functions accomplished by state fund expenditures in
- 6 the previous fiscal year."
- 7 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
