## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Section 103D-110, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "~~§~~103D-110 **Education and training.** (a) The department of  
4 human resources development, either alone or in cooperation with  
5 any governmental body, including the department of labor and  
6 industrial relations, or in cooperation with other states, the  
7 federal government, or other persons may:

8 [~~(1)~~] ~~Develop and maintain a comprehensive training and~~  
9 ~~development program for procurement professionals of~~  
10 ~~the State and the several counties;~~

11 ~~(2)]~~ (1) Conduct or participate in procurement education  
and training for persons not employed by the State;  
13 and

14 [~~(3)]~~ (2) Sponsor a purchasing certification program  
15 conducted by a voluntary organization of procurement  
16 professionals.



1       (b) The state procurement office, in cooperation with the  
2 department of human resources development, shall develop and  
3 maintain a procurement practices training and development  
4 program for procurement officers of the State and the several  
5 counties, to ensure that an agency's procurement practices are  
6 in compliance with the procurement code and that proper  
7 procurement decisions are made consistent with this chapter.  
8 The program shall include a mandatory fundamental training and  
9 development session and follow-up training and development  
10 sessions.

11       (c) Each state procurement officer of a department of the  
12 executive branch shall attend a mandatory fundamental training  
13 and development session within sixty days of being appointed or  
14 named to the position of procurement officer.

15       (d) Each state procurement officer of a department of the  
16 executive branch whom the state procurement office determines is  
17 in need of further training and development based upon:

18       (1) The history of procurement compliance to this chapter  
19 by the agency to which the particular procurement  
20 officer is attached; or

21       (2) Any other need for training and development,  
22 shall attend follow-up training and development sessions.



1           (e) Attendance by state procurement officers at the  
2 follow-up training and development sessions, other than as  
3 required under subsection (d), and by county procurement  
4 officials at the fundamental and follow-up training and  
5 development sessions is optional, though encouraged."

6           SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

8           SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2009.


