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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Section 103D-206, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 **"§103D-206 Additional duties of the administrator of the**  
4 **procurement office.** In addition to the duties referred to in  
5 section 103D-205, the administrator shall:

6 (1) Perform periodic review of the procurement practices  
7 of all governmental bodies;

8 (2) Assist, advise, and guide governmental bodies in  
9 matters relating to procurement;

10 (3) Determine corrective actions; provided that if a  
11 procurement officer under the jurisdiction of the  
12 administrator of the state procurement office or a  
13 chief procurement officer of any of the other state  
14 entities under section 103D-203, fails to comply with  
15 any determination rendered by the administrator within  
16 thirty days from the date of the issuance of the  
17 determination, or longer if permitted by the



1 administrator upon request by the procurement officer  
2 or a chief procurement officer, the procurement  
3 officer or chief procurement officer shall be subject  
4 to an administrative fine under section 103D-106, for  
5 every day of noncompliance;

6 [~~3~~] (4) Develop and administer a statewide procurement  
7 orientation and training program;

8 [~~4~~] (5) Develop, distribute, and maintain a procurement  
9 manual for all state procurement officials; and

10 [~~5~~] (6) Develop, distribute, and maintain a procurement  
11 guide for vendors wishing to do business with the  
12 State and its counties."

13 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2009.
