

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMPLOYMENT SECURITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Act 190, Session Laws of Hawaii 2006, is			
2	amended by amending section 4 to read as follows:
