A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF INFORMATION PRACTICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the office of
- 2 information practices plays a vital role in ensuring public
- access to government documents, while balancing the need to 3
- protect privacy rights. Despite significant budget cuts, the 4
- 5 office of information practices continues to serve government
- agencies and the public by responding to requests for 6
- assistance, guidance and opinions; adopting rules; monitoring 7
- Uniform Information Practices Act related litigation; and 8
- educating by means of presentations, publications, and its 9
- 10 website. In addition, the office of information practices has
- taken on the additional responsibility of administering the open 11
- 12 meetings law. The legislature finds that additional resources
- 13 are necessary to enable the office of information practices to
- 14 respond adequately to requests for assistance as required by
- 15 law.
- 16 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
- 17 office of information practices to add one additional attorney

- 1 in order to allow complaints to be handled in a timely manner,
- 2 to reduce backlog, and to provide more training for the public.
- 3 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$85,000, or so much
- 5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 and the
- 6 same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 7 2008-2009, for one additional attorney in the office of
- 8 information practices.
- 9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the office of
- 10 information practices for the purposes of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
