## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE LAND CONSERVATION FUND.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 173A-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsection (g) to read as follows: 2 3 "(q) The fund shall be used for: The acquisition of interests or rights in land having (1)value as a resource to the State, whether in fee title 5 or through the establishment of permanent conservation 6 7 easements under chapter 198[; and] or agricultural easements; The payment of any debt service relating to the 9 (2) 10 acquisition of interests or rights in land having 11 value as a resource to the State; and  $\left[\frac{(2)}{(2)}\right]$  (3) Annual administration costs for the fund, not to 12 exceed five per cent of annual fund revenues of the 13 previous year." 14 15 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
