RELATING TO CULTURAL IMPACT STUDIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 6E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 "S6E- Comprehensive cultural impact study. The state
- 5 historic preservation division shall require a comprehensive
- 6 cultural impact study to be conducted whenever an environmental
- 7 impact statement is required for a proposed land development in
- 8 the State pursuant to section 343-5. The cultural impact study
- 9 shall carry out the purpose of this chapter to recognize,
- 10 conserve, and develop the historic and cultural heritage of the
- 11 State as an important asset for the enrichment of all of the
- 12 State's residents."
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act shall not apply to any development for
- 14 which an application for a building permit was filed prior to
- 15 its effective date.
- 16 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
