A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE PARKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 184-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "**§184-6 Duties of department.** The department of land and
4 natural resources shall preserve the parks and parkways in the
5 state park system in their natural condition so far as may be
6 consistent with their use and safety, and improve them in such
7 manner as to retain to a maximum extent their natural scenic,
8 historic, and wildlife values for the use and enjoyment of the
9 public.

10 The fundamental purpose of the state park system is to
11 conserve park resources and values. Where there is a conflict
12 between conserving resources and values and providing for
13 enjoyment of those resources, conservation of those resources
14 shall be the predominant concern."

15 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
