# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AFFORDABLE HOUSING.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 201H, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to re	ad as follows:
4	" <u>§20</u>	1H- Affordable housing inventory protection board.
5	(a) Ther	e is established the affordable housing inventory
6	protectio	n board. The board shall be attached to the Hawaii
7	housing finance and development corporation for administrative	
8	purposes only.	
9	<u>(b)</u>	The board shall:
10	<u>(1)</u>	Annually calculate, maintain, and disburse to the
11		legislature accurate recorded estimates of the
12		existing and potential supply of all categories of
13		affordable housing in the State;
14	(2)	Annually calculate, maintain, and disburse to the
15		legislature accurate recorded estimates of the
16		existing and potential demand for all categories of
17		affordable housing in the State; and

1	(3)	Recommend to relevant governmental agencies
2		suggestions to encourage the accumulation and
3		perpetual protection of a combined public and private
4		inventory of one hundred thousand affordable housing
5		opportunities within the State.
6	<u>(c)</u>	The board shall be composed of nine members who shall
7	be appoin	ted by the governor pursuant to section 26-34. Three
8	of the me	mbers shall be selected by the governor from a list of
9	nominees	submitted by the president of the senate and three
10	other app	ointments shall be made from a list of nominees
11	submitted	by the speaker of the house of representatives. All
12	appointed	members shall possess a current working knowledge of
13	<u>affordabl</u>	e housing in the State and shall serve four-year
14	staggered	terms.
15	The	chairperson and vice chairperson of the board shall be
16	selected	by the board by majority vote. Five members shall
17	constitut	e a quorum, whose affirmative vote shall be necessary
18	for all a	ctions by the board. The members shall serve without
19	compensat	ion but shall be reimbursed for expenses, including
20	travel ex	penses, necessary for the performance of their duties.
21	<u>(d)</u>	The board may adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91 to
22	effectuat	e the purposes of this section."

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- 1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ , or so
- 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and
- 4 the same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 5 year 2008-2009, to establish a board to consider issues relating
- 6 to affordable housing inventory.
- 7 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
- 8 department of business, economic development, and tourism for
- 9 the purposes of this Act.
- 10 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
