BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 414D-273, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 2 A foreign corporation may apply for a certificate of 3 "(a) authority to transact business in this State by delivering an 4 application to the department director for filing. 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JUSTIFICATION SHEET

- DEPARTMENT: Commerce and Consumer Affairs
- TITLE: A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO BUSINESS REGISTRATION.
- PURPOSE: To streamline the business registration requirements for foreign nonprofit corporations and foreign limited liability companies.
- MEANS: Amend sections 414D-273(a) and 428-1002(a), Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- Last year, the Department introduced bills JUSTIFICATION: to streamline business registration application forms that affect foreign entities. Act 235, Session Laws of Hawaii 2006, made the changes proposed by the Department. Among the changes were provisions to clarify that a foreign entity must include on its application its current principal office, registered agent, and registered office, rather than the "initial" principal office, registered agent, and registered office. This bill merely makes conforming amendments to the foreign nonprofit corporation law and the foreign limited liability company law.

Impact on the public: This bill eliminates confusion with the business registration requirements with respect to foreign entities by making the laws consistent for all business entities.

Impact on the department and other agencies: Forms and instructions for foreign nonprofit corporations and foreign limited liability companies will need to be revised.
