A BILL FOR AN ACT

ESTABLISHING A COMMISSION TO PLAN FOR THE FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY OF HAWAII STATEHOOD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to create a
- 2 temporary commission composed of members from a wide range of
- 3 Hawaii's communities to plan and coordinate the public
- 4 celebration of the fiftieth anniversary of Hawaii's admission to
- 5 statehood in the United States of America.
- 6 The legislature finds and declares that the appropriation
- 7 under this Act is in the public interest and would benefit the
- 8 residents of Hawaii.
- 9 SECTION 2. (a) There is established a temporary
- 10 commission to be known as the fiftieth anniversary of statehood
- 11 commission consisting of twenty-five members who shall be
- 12 selected as provided in this Act, without regard to section
- 13 26-34, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 14 (b) The commission shall be placed within the office of
- 15 the governor for administrative purposes and shall cease to
- 16 exist after December 31, 2009.



1	(C)	The commission shall be composed of the following
2	members,	whose selection shall be without regard to section
3	26-34, Ha	waii Revised Statutes:
4	(1)	Six members to be selected by the governor from a list
5		of twelve names submitted by the president of the
6		senate;
7	(2)	Six members to be selected by the governor from a list
8		of twelve names submitted by the speaker of the house
9		of representatives;
10	(3)	Five members to be selected by the governor, including
11		persons knowledgeable in the history of Hawaii and
12		Hawaiian culture, event planning, and developing
13		community partnerships;
14	(4)	One member to represent each county, to be selected by
15		the respective mayor of the county;
16	(5)	One member to represent the office of Hawaiian
17		affairs, to be selected by that organization;
18	(6)	One member to represent the Hawaii tourism authority,
19		to be selected by that organization;
20	(7)	One member to represent the state foundation on
21		culture and the arts, to be selected by that
22		organization: and

- 1 (8) One member to represent the military, to be selected
 2 by the commander-in-chief Pacific.
- 3 SECTION 3. The commission shall develop, plan, and
- 4 coordinate various program activities to be scheduled to
- 5 celebrate and commemorate the fiftieth anniversary of the
- 6 admission of Hawaii to statehood, including a series of events
- 7 scheduled for August 2009, and shall submit to the legislature,
- 8 no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular
- 9 session of 2009, a written report of its recommendations,
- 10 including the following:
- 11 (1) A detailed plan on how to execute its recommendations;
- 12 and
- 13 (2) Identifying and recommending procedures for the
- 14 appropriate disbursal of any public funds.
- 15 SECTION 4. The chair of the commission shall be selected
- 16 by the commission members. Members of the commission may elect
- 17 any subordinate officers that the commission deems appropriate
- 18 among the members but, at minimum, shall elect a vice-chair,
- 19 vice-chair for finance, and vice-chair for events.
- 20 SECTION 5. A vacancy on the commission shall be filled by
- 21 the same selection authority that appointed the vacating member.

- 1 SECTION 6. Commission members shall serve on a voluntary
- 2 basis without compensation, but shall be entitled to
- 3 reimbursement for necessary expenses, including travel expenses,
- 4 for attending commission meetings and while in the discharge of
- 5 their duties and responsibilities under this Act.
- 6 SECTION 7. Fifteen members shall constitute a quorum to do
- 7 business. An affirmative vote of thirteen members shall be
- 8 necessary to make decisions. The commission's meeting schedule
- 9 shall be determined by the commission members.
- 10 SECTION 8. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
- 12 much thereof as may be necessary, for fiscal year 2007-2008, to
- 13 be used by the commission for the purposes of this Act.
- 14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the office of the
- 15 governor.
- 16 SECTION 9. Any provision of this Act to the contrary
- 17 notwithstanding, the appropriation authorized under this Act
- 18 shall not lapse of the end of the fiscal year for which the
- 19 appropriation is made; provided that any unexpended and
- 20 unencumbered balance of the appropriation made in this Act as of
- 21 the close of business on December 31, 2009, shall lapse.
- 22 SECTION 10. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2025.
