A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR THE ADULT MENTAL HEALTH DIVISION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended for immediate passage
- 2 in accordance with section 9 of article VII of the Constitution
- 3 of the State of Hawaii.
- SECTION 2. Although funds were appropriated to the 4
- department of health for adult mental health services for the 5
- 6 fiscal period beginning July 1, 2006 and ending June 30, 2007, a
- funding emergency now exists. The program will expend all 7
- appropriated funds before the end of the current fiscal year, 8
- and the department will be unable to meet its fiscal obligation 9
- 10 to provide services to certain adults with severe mental
- 11 illness.
- Over the past four fiscal years, the adult mental health 12
- division has served an increasing number of eligible mental 13
- health consumers and has provided an increased number of crisis 14
- outreach, eligibility determination, homeless outreach, and jail 15
- diversion services. This emergency appropriation is to continue 16
- provisions of existing services to meet the needs of the 17



- 1 expanding eligible population and to continue funding of
- 2 required services developed during the fiscal year. This
- 3 increase in services and the number of consumers served first
- 4 resulted from the settlement agreement and subsequent orders in
- 5 United States of America v. State of Hawaii, Civil Number 91-
- 6 00137 (DAE/KSC), and continues in response to the need for the
- 7 public mental health services the adult mental health division
- 8 provides.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate emergency funds
- 10 for ongoing services of the adult mental health division.
- 11 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$7,958,000 or so much
- 13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 for
- 14 ongoing services provided by the adult mental health division.
- 15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 16 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 4. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 18 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 and
- 19 37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined
- 20 that the general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2006-
- 21 2007 (established at \$5,357,987,705 on November 8, 2006) has
- 22 already been exceeded by \$90,137,694 or 1.68 per cent. The

- 1 appropriations contained in this Act will cause the state
- 2 general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2006-2007 to be
- 3 exceeded by an additional \$7,958,000, or an additional 0.149 per
- 4 cent. The calculation contained in the foregoing sentence
- 5 relates only to the amount of general funds appropriated in this
- $\mathbf{6}$ Act for fiscal year 2006-2007. The reasons for exceeding the
- 7 general fund expenditure ceiling are that the appropriations
- 8 made in this Act are necessary to serve the public interest and
- 9 to meet the needs provided for by this Act.
- 10 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
