A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR CAMPBELL HIGH SCHOOL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. It is incumbent on the State to ensure that all 2 public school classrooms are proper learning environments. For 3 classrooms in certain geographical areas, a proper learning 4 environment requires air conditioning to overcome stifling climate conditions. The classrooms at James Campbell High 5 School are not equipped with air conditioning systems. During 6 long spells of oppressively hot Ewa Beach weather, these 7 8 non-air-conditioned classrooms become unbearable and hinder the 9 academic performances of both students and faculty members. The 10 purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys to install an air 11 conditioning system at James Campbell High School.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$12,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and the same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009, to install an air conditioning system at James Campbell High School.




