A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ADULT PROBATION RECORDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 806-73, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3	"(b) All adult probation records shall be confidential and
4	shall not be deemed [to-be] public records. As used in this
5	section, the term "records" includes, but is not limited to, all
6	records made by any adult probation officer in the course of
7	performing the probation officer's official duties. The
8	records, or the content of the records, shall be divulged only
9	as follows:
10	(1) A copy of any adult probation case record or of a
11	portion of it, or the case record itself, upon
12	request, may be provided to:
13	(A) An adult probation officer, court officer, social
14	worker of a Hawaii state adult probation unit, or
15	a family court officer who is preparing a report
16	for the courts; or
17	(B) A state or federal criminal justice agency, or

state or federal court program that:

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1		(1)	is providing supervision of a defendant or
2			offender convicted and sentenced by the
3			courts of Hawaii; or
4		(ii)	Is responsible for the preparation of a
5			report for a court;
6	(2)	The resid	ence address, work address, home telephone

2		upon	notice to the defendant, records and information

7		(A)	[A] To a case management, assessment or treatment
8			service provider assigned by adult probation to
9			service the defendant; provided that [such] the
10			information shall be given only [upon the
11			acceptance or admittance of the defendant into a
12			treatment program; as part of the determination
13			for admission and the disclosed information shall
14			remain confidential;
15		(B)	[Correctional] To a correctional case manager,
16			correctional unit manager, and parole officers
17			involved with the defendant's treatment or
18			supervision; and
19		(C)	In accordance with applicable law, to persons or
20			entities doing research[-]:

(6) Any person, agency, or entity receiving records, or

contents of records, pursuant to this subsection shall



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1		be subject to the same restrictions on disclosure of
2		the records as Hawaii state adult probation
3		offices[+]; and
4	(7)	Any person who uses the information covered by this
5		subsection for purposes inconsistent with the intent
6		of this subsection or outside of the scope of their
7		official duties shall be fined no more than \$500."
