## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF HAWAIIAN AFFAIRS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 10-9.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$10-9.5 Salary commission; established. (a) There is
- 4 established a salary commission for the members of the board of
- 5 trustees for the office of Hawaiian affairs. The salary
- 6 commission shall consist of seven members appointed by the
- 7 governor on or before August 31, 1999, and every four years
- 8 thereafter [-] up to and including 2007, and every year
- 9 thereafter beginning with 2008. The members of the salary
- 10 commission shall be selected from nominations submitted by
- 11 native Hawaiian organizations as defined in section 673-2(c).
- 12 The members shall serve without compensation, but shall be
- 13 entitled to reimbursement for necessary expenses while in the
- 14 discharge of their duties and responsibilities.
- 15 (b) Before the twentieth legislative day of the regular
- 16 session of 2000 [and], every four years thereafter[7] up to and
- 17 including 2008, and every year thereafter beginning with 2009,
- 18 the salary commission shall study and make recommendations for

- 1 the salary of the members of the board of trustees for the
- 2 office of Hawaiian affairs, and then shall be dissolved. The
- 3 recommended salary shall be effective as of the date of the
- 4 recommendations unless the legislature disapproves the
- 5 recommendation by adoption of a concurrent resolution prior to
- 6 adjournment sine die of the legislative session in which the
- 7 recommendation is submitted."
- 8 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
