## A BILL FOR AN ACT

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 84-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended b	y amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a)	No employee shall take any official action directly
4	affecting	:
5	(1)	A business or other undertaking in which [ <del>he</del> ] <u>the</u>
6		<u>employee</u> has a substantial financial interest; [ <del>or</del> ]
7	(2)	A private undertaking in which [ <del>he</del> ] <u>the employee</u> is
8		engaged as legal counsel, advisor, consultant,
9		representative, or other agency capacity[+]; or
10	(3)	A business or undertaking in which the employee knows
11		or has reason to know that a brother, a sister, a
12		parent, or an emancipated child of the employee has a
13		substantial financial interest; provided that the
14		financial interests of the individual shall not
15		include the interests of a spouse or child.
16	A de	partment head who is unable to disqualify [ <del>himself</del> ] <u>the</u>
17	departmen	t head's self on any matter described in items (1)


