A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR HOMELESS SHELTER PROGRAMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that homelessness is a 2 problem that affects the community's health and public safety on 3 the island of Hawai'i. This appropriation is intended for shelter program operators to provide for repair, renovation 5 (including compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act), 6 upgrade, and expansion of homeless shelter programs. 7 These moneys are to be administered by the Hawai'i county 8 office of housing and community development. 9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$3,000,000, or so 10 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, to 11 12 support homeless shelter programs in the county of Hawai'i. 13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the county of 14 Hawai'i for the purposes of this Act.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
