A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE COUNTY OF HAWAI'I FOR COQUI FROG ERADICATION AND CONTROL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the island of
- 2 Hawai'i continues to be infested by the invasive species of
- 3 Caribbean tree frog, eleutherodactylus coqui, more commonly
- 4 known as coqui frogs, since their accidental introduction on the
- 5 island of Hawai'i in the early 1990's. The county of Hawai'i,
- 6 state department of agriculture, University of Hawai'i at Hilo,
- 7 University of Hawai'i at Manoa, United States Department of
- 8 Agriculture Wildlife Services Division, and the National
- 9 Wildlife Research Center have formed the coqui frog working
- 10 group and have produced the coqui frog working group incident
- 11 action plan to combat this invasive specie which focuses on
- 12 three primary areas: eradication and control, research, and
- 13 community education and support. While the county of Hawai'i,
- 14 the State, and the federal government have contributed in the
- 15 past to this eradication effort, continued assistance is needed
- 16 to deal with the coqui frog problem.
