A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LOANS FOR HEALTH PROFESSIONALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 323F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	"§323F- Loans to health professionals; rural areas;		
5	rural area health professionals loan fund. (a) The Hawaii		
6	health systems corporation shall establish a loan program to		
7	provide interest-free home purchase loans to qualified health		
8	professionals.		
9	(b) Loans made under this section shall be interest-free		
10	and used by the qualified health professional exclusively for		
11	the purchase of a home, including an apartment, townhouse, and		
12	condominium in the State. In addition, loans made under this		
13	section shall be:		
14	(1) Repaid with a payment plan specified by the		
15	corporation; provided that additional payments in any		
16	sums, or the payment of the entire principal, may be		
17	made at any time within the term of the loan;		

1	(2)	Secured in a manner to be determined by the	
2		corporation; and	
3	<u>(3)</u>	Subject to penalties for delinquency or late payments	
4		as specified by the corporation, including penalties	
5		under subsection (c).	
6	The corpo	ration shall negotiate the terms and conditions of each	
7	loan to e	nsure that each loan complies with this section.	
8	<u>(c)</u>	If at any time during the term of a loan, a qualified	
9	health pr	ofessional receiving the loan fails to comply with the	
10	requirements established in the definition of "qualified health		
11	professional" under this section, the loan shall be considered		
12	forfeited and all principal amounts outstanding, plus penalties		
13	shall bec	ome due and payable. If the principal amount	
14	outstandi	ng and penalties are not remitted, the corporation may	
15	initiate	foreclosure proceedings on the home purchased through	
16	the proce	eds from the loan. This subsection shall not apply in	
17	cases whe	re the qualified health professional fails to comply	
18	with the	requirements because of circumstances beyond the	
19	qualified	health professional's control, as determined by the	
20	corporati	on.	
21	<u>(d)</u>	Loans provided under this section shall not exceed	
22	\$	per qualified health professional. Each qualified	
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1 health professional shall receive no more than one loan under 2 this section. 3 (e) There is established in the state treasury a special 4 fund to be known as the rural area health professionals loan 5 fund. The fund shall be administered by the corporation 6 pursuant to this section. The rural area health professionals 7 loan fund shall be funded by: 8 (1) Legislative appropriations; 9 (2) Federal funds, if available; and 10 (3) All principal payments, fees, penalties, and any other 11 proceeds derived by the corporation pursuant to this 12 section. 13 (f) For the purposes of this section: 14 "Qualified health professional" means a licensed physician 15 or an advanced practice registered nurse working at least forty 16 hours per week in a qualified rural area health facility who 17 fulfills the eligibility requirements, if any, specified under 18 subsection (g). "Qualified rural health facility" means a public or private 19 hospital, medical clinic, or physician's office that: 20 21 (1) Has demonstrated difficulty in hiring and retaining

licensed physicians or advanced practice registered

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1		nurses, according to standards and criteria specified	
2		by the corporation; and	
3	(2)	Is located in a rural area that is characterized by a	
4		low population density and the absence of "city-like"	
5		concentration of structures, streets, and urban	
6		services; provided that the corporation may establish	
7		more specific criteria and standards to further define	
8		"rural area".	
9	(g)	The corporation shall adopt rules in accordance with	
10	chapter 9	1 to carry out the purpose of this section, including	
11	rules est	ablishing eligibility requirements for health	
12	professionals applying for loans under this section."		
13	SECT	ION 2. There is appropriated out of the general	
14	revenues	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, for	
15	fiscal year	ar 2007-2008, and the same sum, for fiscal year 2008-	
16	2009, to I	be deposited into the rural area health professionals	
17	loan fund.		
18	SECT	ION 3. There is appropriated out of the rural area	
19	health professionals loan fund the sum of \$, or so		
20	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and		
21	the same	sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal	
22	year 2008	-2009, to be used for the purposes of the fund.	
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- 1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii
- 2 health systems corporation for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 4 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
