## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WATER.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Kaelepulu pond in
- 2 the community of Enchanted Lake on the windward side of Oahu is
- 3 a natural estuary that was formerly part of a native Hawaiian
- 4 fishpond. Kaelepulu pond supports abundant marine fish
- 5 populations and provides a breeding habitat for at least three
- 6 species of endangered Hawaiian waterfowl.
- 7 However, Kaelepulu pond is on the department of health's
- 8 list of impaired waters: the pond and Kailua's canals receive
- 9 runoff from storm drains and sediments as part of the federal
- 10 National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permitting
- 11 program, but the runoff and sediments deposited into these
- 12 bodies of water have contributed to significant shallowing of
- 13 the waters.
- 14 To exacerbate the problem, Kaelepulu pond and Kawai Nui
- 15 stream empty into Kaelepulu stream, which enters the state
- 16 waters of Kailua bay across a state beach and through a popular
- 17 city and county of Honolulu beach park.

- 1 Therefore, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds
- 2 to dredge and install drain inlets, sediment devices, and other
- 3 modifications in Kaelepulu pond.
- 4 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 5 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,325,000 or so much
- 6 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 for:
- 7 (1) Design \$25,000;
- **8** (2) Construction \$800,000;
- 9 (3) Equipment \$500,000,
- 10 to dredge and install drain inlets, sediment devices, and other
- 11 modifications in Kaelepulu pond in Kailua, Oahu.
- 12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 13 land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
