BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

 persons shall be public records and available for inspection and

 7 the legislature, candidates for and delegates to the
 8 constitutional convention, the members of the board of
 9 education, the trustees of the office of Hawaiian
 10 affairs, and candidates for state elective offices;
 - (2) The directors of the state departments and their deputies, regardless of the titles by which the foregoing persons are designated; provided that with respect to the department of the attorney general, the foregoing shall apply only to the attorney general and the first deputy attorney general;
 - (3) The administrative director of the State;

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1	(4)	The members of the board of regents, the president,
2		the vice presidents, the assistant vice presidents,
3		the chancellors, and the provosts of the University of
4		Hawaii;
5	(5)	The superintendent, the deputy superintendent, the
6		state librarian, and the deputy state librarian of the
7		department of education;
8	(6)	The administrative director and the deputy director of
9		the courts; [and]
10	(7)	The administrator and the assistant administrator of
11		the office of Hawaiian affairs[-]; and
12	(8)	The members of the following boards and commissions:
13		(A) The board of agriculture;
14		(B) The Hawaii community development authority;
15		(C) The board of trustees of the employees'
16		retirement system;
17		(D) The Hawaiian homes commission;
18		(E) The board of land and natural resources;
19		(F) The land use commission;
20		(G) The public utilities commission;
