## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COURT APPEARANCE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 605-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§605-2 Attorneys; license required; exceptions. (a)
- 4 Except as provided by the rules of court, no person shall be
- 5 allowed to practice in any court of the State unless that person
- 6 has been duly licensed so to do by the supreme court [7 provided
- 7 that nothing].
- 8 (b) Nothing in this chapter shall prevent any person,
- 9 plaintiff, defendant, or accused, from appearing in person
- 10 before any court, and there prosecuting or defending that
- 11 person's, plaintiff's, defendant's, or accused's own cause,
- without the aid of legal counsel[+].
- (c) Nothing in this chapter shall prevent any person, who
- 14 owns one hundred per cent of the issued shares of a foreign or
- 15 domestic corporation, from appearing in person before any court,
- 16 and there prosecuting or defending that corporation's own cause,
- 17 without the aid of legal counsel.
