A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 431:10C-208, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
2 is amended to read as follows:

3 "§431:10C-208 Increase in premiums prohibited. (a) No
4 premium on any motor vehicle insurance policy shall be increased
5 as a result of any accident if the insured is not at fault in
6 the accident. An accident in which the insured was not at fault
7 shall not be used in any way to affect any subsequent increases,
8 including loss of any discounts, in insurance premiums.

9 (b) No premium on any motor vehicle insurance policy shall
10 be increased as a result of any traffic violation if the traffic
11 violation is dismissed by court order. A traffic violation that
12 is dismissed by court order shall not be used in any way to
13 affect any subsequent increases, including loss of any
14 discounts, in insurance premiums."

15 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
