BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 "\$8- Peace Day. September 21 of each year shall be
- 5 known and recognized as peace day. All citizens shall be
- 6 encouraged to observe and celebrate the blessings of peace and
- 7 endeavor to create peace on peace day. Peace Day shall serve as
- 8 a focal point to promote peace programs, improve international
- 9 relations, and increase educational awareness of peace and shall
- 10 include discussions of the professional activities and
- 11 achievements in the lives of peacemakers."
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 8-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended
- 13 to read as follows:
- 14 "\$8-1 Holidays designated. The following days of each
- 15 year are set apart and established as state holidays:
- 16 The first day in January, New Year's Day;
- 17 The third Monday in January, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.,
