A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE BOARD OF EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to provide salaries
- 2 for board of education members and require them to serve on a
- 3 full-time basis.
- 4 SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 5 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 6 and to read as follows:
- 7 "\$302A- Salary commission; established. (a) There is
- 8 established a salary commission for the members of the board of
- 9 education. The salary commission shall consist of seven members
- 10 appointed by the governor before September 1, 2008, and every
- 11 four years thereafter. The members of the salary commission
- 12 shall be selected from nominations submitted by the president of
- 13 the senate and speaker of the house of representatives. The
- 14 members shall serve without compensation, but shall be entitled
- 15 to reimbursement for necessary expenses incurred in the
- 16 discharge of their duties and responsibilities.

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              Before the twentieth legislative day of the regular
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    session of 2009 and every four years thereafter, the salary
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    commission shall study and make recommendations to the
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    legislature for the salary of the members of the board of
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    education. The salary commission shall be dissolved on June 30,
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    2009, and on June 30 every four years thereafter in which it
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    submits recommendations to the legislature. The recommended
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    salary shall be effective as of the date of the recommendation,
    unless the legislature disapproves the recommendation by
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    adoption of a concurrent resolution prior to adjournment sine
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    die of the legislative session in which the recommendation is
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    submitted."
         SECTION 3. Section 302A-1101, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
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    amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
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               There shall be a principal executive department to be
    known as the department of education, which shall be headed by
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    an elected policy-making board to be known as the board of
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    education. Members of the board shall serve on a full-time
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    basis. The board shall have power in accordance with law to
    formulate statewide educational policy, adopt student
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    performance standards and assessment models, monitor school

3	SECTION 4. Section 302A-1105, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
4	amended t	o read as follows:
