A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A GRANT-IN-AID TO THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO DESIGN AND CONSTRUCT A SIDEWALK ON THE NORTH SIDE OF WAIPAHU STREET, OAHU.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that pedestrian safety is
- 2 important to the health and well-being of the community. The
- 3 legislature further finds that the north side of Waipahu Street,
- 4 specifically from Waipahu Depot Road to Awamoi Street and from
- 5 Amokii Street to Waikele Road on Oahu, is heavily used by
- 6 children, adults, and motor vehicles. However, a significant
- 7 hazard exists for pedestrians because in this area there are no
- 8 sidewalks; and where sidewalks do exist, they are broken,
- 9 unsafe, and in desperate need of repair.
- 10 The purpose of this Act is to ensure that this area is made
- 11 safe for pedestrians.
- 12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so much
- 14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, as a
- 15 grant-in-aid to the city and county of Honolulu for expenditures
- 16 for the design and construction of a sidewalk on the north side

- 1 of Waipahu Street from Waipahu Depot Road to Awamoi Street and
- 2 from Amokii Street to Waikele Road.
- 3 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
- 4 city and county of Honolulu for the purposes of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
