## A BILL FOR AN ACT

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 1-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to read as follows:
3	"\$1-1 Common law of the State; exceptions. The common law
4	of England, as ascertained by English and American decisions, is
5	declared to be the common law of the State of Hawaii in all
6	cases, except as otherwise expressly provided by [the]:
7	(1) The Constitution or laws of the United States[ <del>, or by</del>
8	the];
9	(2) The laws of the State[ <del>, or fixed by</del> ];
10	(3) Hawaiian judicial precedent[ <del>, or established by</del> ]; or
11	(4) Hawaiian usage;
12	provided that no person shall be subject to criminal proceedings
13	except as provided by the written laws of the United States or
14	of the State."
15	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
16	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
