RELATING TO GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 710-1010, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows: 3 "(1) A person commits the offense of obstructing 4 government operations if, by using or threatening to use 5 violence, force, or physical interference or obstacle, the 6 person intentionally obstructs, impairs, or hinders: 7 (a) The performance of a governmental function by a public servant who is acting under color of the public servant's official authority; 9 (b) The enforcement of the penal law or the preservation 10 11 of the peace by a law enforcement officer who is acting under color of the law enforcement officer's 12 13 official authority; or (c) The operation of a radio, telephone, television, or 14 15 other telecommunication system owned or operated by the State or one of its political subdivisions." 16
