BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

21 follows:

2 SECTION 5. The sums appropriated for the respective
3 capital projects set forth in this Act shall be expended by the
4 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act;
5 provided that all construction and renovation work under this
6 Act shall meet or exceed the Leadership in Energy and
7 Environmental Design silver rating system or another comparable
8 state-approved, nationally recognized, and consensus based
9 guideline standard, or system, except when the guideline
10 standard or system interferes or conflicts with the use of the
11 building or facility as an emergency shelter.

12 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
