A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A COMMUNITY-BASED AQUACULTURE PROGRAM IN HONOKAA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to establish an
- 2 educational program under which local aquacultural farmers would
- 3 provide Honokaa school students with hands-on training, through
- 4 class work as well as after school activities, in all phases of
- 5 aguacultural production, including the breeding, raising, and
- 6 distribution of the fish.
- 7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$100,000, or so much
- 9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, for a
- 10 community-based aquaculture program in Honokaa, Hawaii.
- 11 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
- 12 department of education for the purposes of this Act.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
