RELATING TO CRIMINAL PROPERTY DAMAGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 708-823.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$708-823.5 Aggravated criminal property damage. (1) A
- 4 person commits the offense of aggravated criminal property
- 5 damage if the person by means other than fire:
- 6 (a) Intentionally damages the property of another without
- 7 the other's consent; and
- **8** (b) Has been convicted [two] one or more times of an
- 9 offense under section 708-822 or 708-823 in the
- preceding five years.
- 11 (2) For purposes of this section, "convicted [two] one or
- 12 more times" means that, at the time of the instant offense, the
- 13 person had previously entered a plea of quilty or no contest or
- 14 a judge or jury had previously returned a verdict of guilty
- 15 against the person for [two] one or more offenses committed on
- 16 separate occasions.
- 17 (3) Aggravated criminal property damage is a misdemeanor.

- 1 (4) A person convicted for a first offense of aggravated
- 2 criminal property damage shall be sentenced to community service
- 3 time of eighty hours spent eradicating graffiti damage. The
- 4 cost of paint and materials shall be borne by the person, if not
- 5 provided.
- 6 (5) A person convicted of a second and subsequent offenses
- 7 of aggravated criminal property damage shall be sentenced to
- 8 community service time of one hundred-sixty hours spent
- 9 eradicating graffiti damage. The cost of paint and materials
- 10 shall be borne by the person, if not provided."
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 12 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 13 begun, before its effective date.
- 14 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 16 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
