BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose an
amendment to article X, section 2, of the Constitution of the
State of Hawaii to allow the student member of the board of
education to vote.

5 SECTION 2. Article X, section 2, of the Constitution of6 the State of Hawaii is amended to read as follows:



"BOARD OF EDUCATION

8 Section 2. There shall be a board of education composed of 9 members who shall be elected in a nonpartisan manner by qualified voters, as provided by law, from two at-large school 10 11 board districts. The first school board district shall be 12 comprised of the island of Oahu and all other islands not 13 specifically enumerated. The second school board district shall 14 be comprised of the islands of Hawaii, Maui, Lanai, Molokai, Kahoolawe, Kauai and Niihau. Each at-large school board 15 16 district shall be divided into departmental school districts, as 17 may be provided by law. There shall be at least one member
