A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 132D-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows:

 "\$132D-3 Permissible uses of consumer fireworks[-]; and prohibitions. (a) Consumer fireworks may be set off, ignited,
- 5 discharged, or otherwise caused to explode within the State
- 6 only:
- 7 (1) From 9:00 p.m. on New Year's Eve to 1:00 a.m. on New

 8 Year's Day; from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Chinese New

 9 Year's Day; and from 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on the

 10 Fourth of July; or
- 11 (2) From 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. as allowed by permit

 12 pursuant to section 132D-10 if the proposed cultural

 13 use is to occur at any time other than during the

 14 periods prescribed in paragraph (1);
- 15 provided that the purchase of not more than five thousand
- 16 individual consumer fireworks commonly known as firecrackers
- 17 shall be allowed under each permit.



1	(b) It shall be unlawful to sell or use non-aerial common
2	fireworks on the Fourth of July in counties with populations
3	over 500,000."
4	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
5	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
