A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that existing law in Act
- 2 186, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, relating to schools, requires
- 3 the department of education to be responsible to ensure that
- 4 asbestos testing is conducted prior to any exterior or interior
- 5 renovations or painting of school facilities, if the surfaces
- 6 have not been previously tested.
- 7 The federal Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act requires
- 8 asbestos testing only if there are suspected asbestos containing
- 9 materials that would be affected during renovation or painting
- 10 of school facilities.
- 11 The legislature finds that current law requiring the
- 12 testing of any surface can result in unnecessary cost.
- 13 The purpose of this Act is to conform Hawaii law to the
- 14 mandates of the federal law.
- 15 SECTION 2. Act 186, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, is
- 16 amended by amending section 2 to read as follows:

- 1 "SECTION 2. The department of education shall be
- 2 responsible for ensuring that asbestos testing is conducted on
- 3 all suspected asbestos-containing materials as required by the
- 4 federal Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act of 1986 prior to
- 5 any exterior or interior renovations or painting of school
- 6 facilities at all department of education schools, except
- 7 charter schools, provided that the surfaces have not previously
- 8 been tested."
- 9 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
