A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the scope and level
2	of responsibilities of the board of education merits increased
3	compensation to its members, including a protocol allowance for
4	expenses.
5	The purpose of this Act is to increase the current rate of
6	compensation for members of the board of education.
7	SECTION 2. Section 302A-1105, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
8	amended to read as follows:
9	"§302A-1105 Compensation; expenses. Board [of education]
10	members shall be allowed:
11	(1) Compensation at the rate of [\$100] \$120 per day for
12	each day's actual attendance at meetings;
13	(2) Transportation fares between islands and abroad; [and]
14	(3) Personal expenses at [the] rates specified by the
15	board while attending board meetings or while on
16	official business as authorized by the chairperson,
17	when the board meetings or official business require a

1	board member to leave the island upon which the board
2	member resides[-]; and
3	(4) A protocol allowance to cover expenses incurred in the
4	course of a member's duties and responsibilities."
5	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
6	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
7	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and
8	the same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
9	year 2008-2009, for the purposes of this Act.
10	The sums appropriated in this section shall be expended by
11	the department of education for the purposes of this Act.
12	SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
13	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
14	SECTION 5. This Act shall take upon its approval; provided
15	that section 3 shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
