A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 711, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§711- Endangering public health and safety by using
5	body-gripping traps. (a) Notwithstanding section 183D-6, it
6	shall be unlawful to use, set, place, maintain, or tend, or
7	cause to be used, set, placed, maintained, or tended any body-
8	gripping trap.
9	(b) For purposes of this section, the term "body-gripping
10	trap" includes, but is not limited to, steel-jawed leghold
11	traps, padded jaw leghold traps, conibear traps, and snares, the
12	last of which are commonly referred to as cable restraints.
13	(c) Subsection (a) does not apply:
14	(1) To federal, state, or county, departments of health
15	when protecting human health and safety; or
16	(2) To the use of traps for rodent control for the purpose
17	of controlling wild or domestic rodents.
