A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LEGISLATIVE INQUIRIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 37, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and to read 2 as follows: 3 "PART SALARIES 5 §37-Appropriations available for salaries. 6 of any appropriation shall be available for the payment of the 7 salary of any officer or employee of the State who: (1)Prohibits or prevents, or attempts or threatens to prohibit or prevent, any officer or employee of the 9 10 State from having any direct oral or written 11 communication or contact with any member of the 12 legislature or a state legislative committee in 13 connection with any matter pertaining to the employment of the other officer or employee or 14 15 pertaining to the department or agency of the other 16 officer or employee in any way, regardless of whether

3	(2)	Removes, suspends from duty without pay, demotes,
