BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the establishment of
a revolving fund for the department of education's office of
Hawaii child nutrition program is necessary to account for the
receipts from the administrative fees charged to the recipient
agencies for the distribution of federal commodity foods.

6 The legislature further finds that the United States 7 Department of Agriculture Food and Nutrition Service, Western 8 Region Office, monitors and approves the administrative fees 9 charged to the recipient agencies. However, federal legislation 10 does not allow the department of education to expend federal 11 moneys for the operations of state contracted warehouses.

12 The purpose of this Act is to create a revolving fund for 13 the collection and disbursement of generated revenue to support 14 the administration and operation of the department of education 15 food distribution program, including payments to contracted 16 warehouses.

2	fund shall not exceed the sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof
3	as may be necessary to pay for services rendered by state
4	contracted warehouses for the distribution of federal commodity
5	foods to recipient agencies. Any unexpended and unencumbered
6	moneys remaining in the revolving fund in excess of \$2,000,000
7	at the close of each fiscal year shall lapse to the credit of
8	the state general fund.
