EXPERIMENTAL MODERNIZATION PROJECTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 78-3.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[+] §78-3.5[+] Experimental modernization projects. (a)
- 4 It is the intent of this section to encourage and facilitate
- 5 improvements in the human resource programs of the several
- 6 jurisdictions. With the approval of the [chief executive]
