I transmit to you a copy of our report, Study of the Social and Financial Impacts of Mandatory Health Insurance Coverage for Use of Intelligent Medical Vigilance Services in Acute Care Hospitals.

Intelligent medical vigilance refers to a system or device with two components: a *bedside unit* connected to a *pad or coverlet* with embedded sensory technology developed and patented by Hoana Medical, Inc. An assessment of the social and financial impacts of requiring health insurers to offer coverage for the use of intelligent medical vigilance services was not feasible since the term refers to a specific product rather than a specific health care service covered under Section 23-51, Hawai'i Revised Statutes. The Departments of Commerce and Consumer Affairs and Health opted not to provide responses.
