BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

Section 323D-45, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§323D-45 Subarea council, review panel, and statewide council joint recommendations for issuance or denial of 4 5 certificates of need. (a) Except for an administrative review 6 as provided in section 323D-44.5, or in an emergency situation 7 or other unusual circumstances as provided in section 323D-44(c), the state agency shall refer every application for a 8 certificate of need to a joint review panel consisting of the 9 10 appropriate subarea council or councils, the review panel, and 11 the statewide council. The subarea council [and the], review 12 panel, and statewide council shall consider all relevant data 13 and information submitted by the state agency, [subarea councils, other areawide or local bodies, and the applicant, 14 15 and may request from them additional data and information. The subarea councils, review panel, and statewide council shall 16 jointly consider each application at a public meeting and shall 17 18 submit its recommendations with findings to the [statewide HB HMS 2007-1392

Description:

Reforms the certificate of need review process to require a joint hearing of a subarea council or councils, review panel, and statewide council; provides a waiver from the certificate of need requirements for the construction and operation of a new West Maui acute care hospital.
