### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LONG-TERM CARE FACILITIES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 46, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended 1 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to 2 3 read as follows: Long-term care facilities; permitted use in 4 residential areas. (a) For the purposes of zoning, long-term 5 care facilities shall be considered a residential use of 6 property and shall be a permitted use in all residentially 7 designated zones, including but not limited to zones for single-8 family dwellings. No conditional use permit, variance, or 9 10 special exception shall be required for residences used as long-11 term care facilities. (b) For the purposes of this section, "long-term care 12 facility" means any skilled nursing facility as defined in 13 section 1861(j) of the Social Security Act, as amended, any 14 intermediate care facility as defined in section 1905(c) of the 15 Social Security Act, as amended, any nursing home as defined in 16

section 1908(e) of the Social Security Act, as amended, and any
